## Traffic Alert for Area Roads

---

**Chipley** – Drivers are reminded to practice caution while traveling in and around work zones in Northwest Florida.

### Bay County:

- **State Road (S.R.) 30 (U.S. 98) at S.R. 368 (23rd Street)**– Access to Brown Avenue north at the U.S. 98 intersection in Bay County will closed beginning Sunday, Dec. 3 at 10:30 p.m. for pipe laying operations.
- **S.R. 390 from Baldwin Road to Jenks Avenue** – Construction crews are striping travel lanes, between Token Road and Jenks Avenue. The current S.R. 390 north and southbound travel lanes will remain open during the work activities.
- Drivers can expect lane restrictions on **U.S. 98 from the main gate at Tyndall AFB to the Mexico Beach city limits** as workers pave.
- Construction on **S.R. 391 (Airport Road) from Harrison Avenue to south of Fortune Avenue** will begin soon.
- Turn lane work is underway on **U.S. 98 at Pier Park Drive and at Lullwater Drive**. Drivers are reminded to use caution.
- Drivers will encounter intermittent lane closures Tuesday, Dec. 5 and Wednesday, Dec. 6, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. as workers remove pavement core samples from **S.R. 77 from the Washington County line to Southport**.

### Jackson County:

- **I-10 from east of S.R. 71 to east of County Road (C.R.) 69A** – Beginning Sunday, Dec. 3 and continuing through Thursday, Dec. 7, drivers will encounter temporary lane closures from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. as workers stripe the corridor.
- **S.R. 276 at C.R. 10A (Old Cottondale Highway)** – Intersection improvement work is underway. Workers are preparing to install turn lanes. Drivers are reminded to use caution while traveling through the new traffic signal.
- **S.R. 71 over Cypress Creek and over Chipola Creek** – A routine bridge inspection will take place, Tuesday, Dec. 5 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Drivers will encounter temporary lane restrictions.

All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to pay attention to the reduced speed limit when traveling through the construction area.
