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### FDOT Traffic Advisory for Area Roads

**Chipley** – Drivers will encounter traffic disruptions on the following state roads in Bay, Gulf, and Jackson counties as crews perform construction and maintenance activities.

#### Bay County:

- **State Road (S.R.) 390 Widening from Jenks Avenue to S.R. 77** – Crews continue widening efforts. The following pedestrian and vehicular impacts are associated with the project.
  - A bicycle lane detour is in place between the intersections of Jenks Avenue and Northshore Road, S.R. 77 and West 14th Street.
  - Virginia Avenue between 14th Street and S.R. 390 has been permanently closed.
  - The speed limit in the work zone is reduced to 35 mph.
- **S.R. 390 Widening from Jenks Avenue to Baldwin Road** - The intersection of S.R. 390 and 34th Place will be closed from 6 a.m. Tuesday, June 11 through 8 p.m. Thursday, June 14 as crews perform drainage operations. The closure will start at the intersection and continue east for approximately 100-yards. S.R. 390 drivers destined for 34th Place can utilize Baldwin Road and Token Road during the temporary closure.
- **U.S. 98 Hurricane Michael Permanent Repairs from Saltcreek Bridge to Gulf County Line** – Traffic will encounter a temporary detour as crews continue permanent repairs. The detour will be in place until July 2019. Motorists traveling on U.S. 98 will utilize the following:
  - *Eastbound* U.S. 98 traffic will utilize 15th Street and County Road (C.R.) 286 back to U.S. 98.
  - *Westbound* U.S. 98 traffic will utilize C.R. 386 and 15th Street back to U.S. 98.

#### Gulf County:

- **U.S. 98 Hurricane Michael Permanent Repairs from Ninth Street to Fourteenth Street** – Drivers can expect intermittent daytime lane closures as crews make permanent repairs to the roadway caused by Hurricane Michael.

- **U.S. 98 Hurricane Michael Permanent Repairs from Franklin County Line to Bay County Line** – Washout preventative operations prior to paving the roadway continue. These operations will strengthen the road and prevent storm related damages in the future. Intermittent lane closures may be experienced during this time.
- **U.S. 98 Hurricane Michael Permanent Repairs from Gulf Street to Bay Street** – Intermittent daytime lane closures are scheduled Monday, June 10 through Friday, June 14 as crews begin permanent hurricane recovery operations on the roadway.

**Jackson County:**

- **U.S. 231 Resurfacing from Peanut Road to north of S.R. 73-** Drivers may encounter intermittent north and southbound lane restrictions from Monday, June 10 until Friday, June 14 as crews continue construction activities.
- **U.S. 231 Resurfacing from Pike Pond Road to Mill Road-** Drivers may encounter intermittent north and southbound lane restrictions from Monday, June 10 until Friday, June 14 as crews continue construction activities.

All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to pay attention to the reduced speed limit when traveling through the construction area.
